## **INSTRUCTIONS**

The St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Medal is sponsored by the National Federation for Catholic Youth Ministry (NFCYM) and is administered by the Archdiocese of Santa Fe Catholic Committee on Scouting with the approval of the local Ordinary. It may be presented to any adult who is working in youth programs under Catholic auspices (e.g. Church Youth Ministry; Girl Scouts of the USA; Camp Fire; American Heritage Girls; Scouting America; etc.). It is also available for award to Catholic adults serving in youth organizations not partnered by the Church. It is intended to recognize those who have made significant and meritorious contributions to youth faith development in the field of Catholic relationships. It can be given to men, women, priests, religious or non-Catholics.

Nominations must be submitted to the Archdiocese of Santa Fe Catholic Committee on Scouting by email no later than June 1st of each calendar year. Send completed nominations and any supporting documents by email to: <u>ReligiousAwards@catholicscoutsnm.org</u>. Incomplete nominations, or those received without proper approvals will not be considered. The deadline for submissions will not be extended for incomplete nomination forms. If a nominee is selected, they will be presented with the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Award/Medal at the annual Awards Conferral Mass held in the fall.

There is no limit on annual awards allocations for this honor; submit people as they are deserving. There shall be no honorary or posthumous recognitions.

If possible, the nominee should not be made aware of the nomination until approved and selected for the award. The award seeks the individual; the individual does not seek the award.

Upon receipt of nominations the Archdiocese of Santa Fe CCOS will convene a selection committee to review and select the award recipients. This selection committee will follow the guidelines outlined in the below section and the Archdiocese of Santa Fe CCOS bylaws.

# **GUIDE FOR THE SELECTION COMMITTEE**

The committee will review received nominations based on the person's demonstration of good character, contributions to youth spiritual development, and exemplary service to the individual's volunteer program. The committee will only use what is written on this nomination form to make the determination to award or not to award.

The following examples are offered as a guide in selecting candidates for this recognition. These are suggestions only; however, they are indicative of some of the things a committee member should be looking for. This list is not inclusive.

- a) Support to programs that promote spiritual development of female Catholic youth.
- b) Notable service in promoting Catholic activities and willingness to serve on committees.
- c) Participation in Retreats, Days of Recollection, etc. Instrumental in having other people participate.
- d) Notable service in bringing Scouting and other youth ministries, to more Catholic youth.
- e) Assist parishes and organizations recruiting leaders for Scouting and/or other Catholic youth ministries.
- f) Inaugurated many service projects for the parish, Church, and/or charitable organizations.
- g) Other notable contributions to the betterment of parish, Church, society, and family.

The award background does not stipulate minimum years of service within Catholic Youth Ministries, and/or a Scouting program. Rather the award nominee should be selected based on consideration of the type and level of work accomplished and the nominee's dedication.

Nomination for an adult recognition is not to be considered an automatic grant of any given award. It is the role of the Selection Committee to determine the eligibility of each nominee and make selections based upon the criteria set forth for the recognition. After the selection board agrees on the candidates to award, the selections are then subject to final approval by the Archdiocese of Santa Fe CCOS Chaplain and local Ordinary.

If a nominee is not selected for granting the award each year their nomination form shall be retained and automatically re-submitted for consideration the following year only. Subsequent non-selection will result in the candidate having to be formally re-nominated on a separate newly submitted form.
